Subject: **TENDER FOR REHABILITATION WORK OF STEEL FOUNDRY SHOP.**

1. Sealed tenders are invited from experienced contractors for the subject work, who have necessary experience to carry out similar kind of work with Government / Semi Government or other Private Organizations so as to reach project incharge in the office of DGM (Foundries & Tech) latest by, 1100 hr on December 7th, 2017. The tenders will be opened at 11:30 hrs on the same day in the presence of bidders who may like to be present.
2. Tender fee is Rs. 500/- non refundable which will have to be deposited with chief cashier HMC Taxila.
3. The tender documents can be collected from the office of DGM (Foundries & Tech.) during the office hours from Dt.14-11-2017 to Dt. 06-12-2017 (except holidays). No tender will be issued on the date of opening of tender.
4. Proof of already executed jobs should be submitted along with application for the issuance of tender documents, otherwise no tender will be issued.
5. CDR/DD/ Pay order or cash on account of earnest money equal to 2% of the tender value drawn in favor of Heavy Mechanical Complex, Taxila must accompany the tender, otherwise the tender will be rejected.
6. List of manpower, tools & equipment necessary to carry out subject work and list of similar works carried out must be attached with the tender.
7. The management reserves the rights to reject any or all the tenders as per provisions of PPRA rules.
8. Completion period of the work is 03 months from the date of written work order given to the contractor.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The interested Parties may visit Steel Foundry, HMC Taxila to determine the nature of work and inspect the roof and its working condition.
2. The quantities of the work are estimated which can be increased / decreased as per requirement and order of HMC. Payment will how ever be made according to actual work done at site and measured& verified by the project incharge.
3. The contractor should quote labour rates for all items as illustrated in the relevant column of B. O. Q.
4. Payments will be made on fortnightly basis upon submission of bill duly verified by Project Incharge.
5. 10% security will be deducted from all the bills payable to contractor, which will be released 03 months after completion of the work, subject to satisfactory performance / service of the roof.
6. In case of dispute, decision of MD (HMC) will be final and binding upon both the parties.
7. The work will have to be scheduled and arranged in co-ordination with shop incharge so as not to effect working of shop.
8. Safety of the all personals of the contractor will be the contractor's responsibility. Adoption of proper safety measures will be the responsibility of the contractor. HMC will not be responsible for any mishap, loss of life or damage to contractor's equipments / manpower.
9. The contractor will be responsible to compensate / pay for any damage caused to the property / equipment of HMC, incurred due to action / negligence of the contractors manpower / equipment.
10. Electric & gas supply will be provided by HMC on free of cost basis.
11. Work will be done as per standard specifications and as per instruction and satisfaction of shop incharge.
12. Completion period of the work is 03 months from the date of written work order given to the contractor.
13. All the tools, equipments, scaffolding, manpower required to complete the work will have to be arranged by the contractor.
14. All materials to be incorporated in work including MS sections, welding rods, nuts bolts, washers, corrugated and plain sheets, AC sheets, paints etc will be provided by HMC. Material required from execution of running work should be intimated to project incharge in writing by the contractor at least 03 days before actual use.

15. The contractor will have to pay the liquidated damages as compensation for daily equal to 0.05% of the tender value every day that the work remains in completed or unfinished after stipulated period provided that the entire amount of the compensation to be paid under the provision of this clause shall not exceed, 10% of the work shown in the work order.
16. The work will be started 03 days or earlier after receipt of the work order and must be completed within 03 months.
17. It must be clearly understood by the contractor that claims on accounts of fluctuation in the market price of labour, material and equipment or on account of Taxes ect. Will not be entrained.
18. The Management reserves the rights to reject any or all the tenders as per provision of PPRA rules.
19. CDR/DD/ Pay order on account of the earnest money equal to 2%(Two percent) of the tender value drawn in favor of GM, (Finance & Accounts) HMC. Taxila must accompany the tender; otherwise the tender will be rejected.
20. Income tax as per rules at prevailing rates will be deducted from all the payments made to the contractor.
21. Contractor will provide list of equipments available with him, which will be required for execution of said work.
22. Measurement of corrugated sheets will be done for the net area fixed on roof. No payment will be made for end or side overlaps.
23. Measurement of 02 coats of bituminous paint will be for both sides of the sheets, net area of roof will be paid. No payment will be made for end or side overlaps.
