Benazir Income Support Programme (BISP) is the largest social safety net, established under BISP Act 2010 (No. XVIII of 2010) to provide income support and other social protection and safety net measures to economically unprivileged segment of the society. BISP has identified eligible poor families using a Poverty Scorecard conducted through a house to house census. BISP has initiated a Waseela-e-Taleem Programme, to financially support the primary education of children having ages between 4 – 12 years of BISP Beneficiary families for their enrolment and retention in schools. The said programme is currently being implemented in 50 districts across the country under which each beneficiary child is receiving an additional cash transfer of Pak. Rs. 750 per quarter upon meeting the admission verification in 1st quarter and attendance requirement of 70% in subsequent quarters till completion of primary education

BISP's Waseela-e-TaleemProgramme, is a complementary initiative linked to the UCT schem and is an integral part of the beneficiary families' graduation strategy. Under the WeTProgramme, BISP provides conditional assistance to the eligible children of BISP's UCS scheme's selected beneficiary families so that they could complete primary education of the children aging from 5 to 12 years, in conformity with the permissible compliance paramete including the maximum duration of seven years. For the implementation of WeTProgramme, BISP has the support of Development Partner (International Donors). After successful rollout the Programme in thirty two (32) selection districts, BISP's Development Partners committed to extend their support to BISP in further rolling out of WeTProgramme, therefore, it was decided to expand the programme in addition eighteen (18) districts, selected across the country& clubbed in two geographical cluster enabling BISP Beneficiaries of those districts to obtain the benefit of the WeTProgramme
