# Part-II Qualification and Experience of Consultant' Key Personnel

Consultant will assign adequately qualified key personnel to carry out the implementation of the Project & man-months inputs for which are indicated above. In particular, the key personnel should possess the qualification and experience as indicated in following.

### Project Manager/Team Leader

He should have at least a Bachelor Degree in Electrical/Mechanical/Civil Engineering from a recognized University. He should have specific experience of working in senior Techno-managerial positions on similar projects. He should have overall minimum experience of 20 years with 10 years as Team Leader/Construction Manager. In case of Masters in Engineering, the overall experience should be 15 years with 8 years as Team Leader/Construction Manager. He should have minimum 05 eligible assignments on his credit with accumulative line length of not less than 120km. He should be able to lead the team of Consultant and assist NTDC in timely implementation of the project with a quality output. He shall be the Leader of the Team and act as the consultant's representative on all matters related to the assignment. He shall keep close contacts with NTDC and shall be responsible for timely submission of reports and other documents.

#### 2. Contracts Expert

He should have at least bachelor degree in relevant field from a recognized university with 15 years over all experience. He should have minimum 02 eligible assignments on his credit with accumulative line length of not less than 70km.

### 3. Construction Supervision Expert (Electrical)

He should have at least bachelor degree in Electrical Engineering from a recognized university with 15 years of overall experience. He should have minimum 02 eligible assignments on his credit with accumulative line length of not less than 70km.

### 4. Junior Construction Supervision Engineer (Electrical)

He should have at least bachelor degree in Electrical Engineering from a recognized university with 04 years of overall experience and minimum 02 years of exposure to relevant field. He should have minimum 01 eligible assignment on his credit and line length of not less than 40km. He should not be more than 40 years of age.

# 5. Construction Supervision Expert (Civil)

He should have at least bachelor degree in Civil Engineering from a recognized university with 15 years of overall experience. He should have minimum 03 eligible assignments (involving construction supervision of tower foundations) on his credit with accumulative line length of not less than 100km.

# 6. Junior Construction Supervision Engineer (Civil)

He should have at least bachelor degree in Civil Engineering from a recognized university with 04 years of overall experience. He should have minimum 01 eligible assignments (involving construction supervision of tower foundations) on his credit and accumulative line length of not less than 40km. He should not be more than 40 years of age.

# Testing and Commissioning Expert

He should have at least bachelor degree in Electrical Engineering from a recognized university with 15 years over all experience. He should have minimum 03 eligible assignments on his credit with accumulative line length of not less than 120km.

- c. The consultant will prepare quarterly progress reports on physical and financial progress of the project and distribute these to NTDC. Summarizing the construction activities indicating among other things, disbursement, accomplishment, activities, contract changes, claims or disputes or any other substantive matters having an effect on the amount, cost and progress of the work.
- d. Upon completion of the project the Consultant will prepare the Project Completion Report.

All reports/documents should be in English language and content/format of the same should be finalized with concurrence of NTDC. For each report submitted an electronic copy will also be provided.

#### 4. COMPLETION PERIOD

All the works are required to be completed within Thirty (30) months including Defect Liability Period of 12 months after the commencement of works by the Contractors.

### 5. ELIGIBILITY/QUALIFICATION CRITERIA FOR CONSULTANT /JV

- a. Applicant firm/JV must have minimum of 10 years of working experience on projects of Transmission Lines.
- b. Applicant firm/JV must have, during last 10 years, provided consultancy services (project management and construction supervision etc.) of at least 50 Km (accumulative) of 220kV or above rating transmission line projects involving route survey, plans & profiles, civil works, erection of towers, stringing of conductor & OHS/OPGW, telecommunication works, testing & commissioning and other allied activities.
- c. Each individual Firm/JV partner must be registered with Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) in appropriate category. Only national/local consulting firms are eligible to participate.
- d. Only those consultants will be eligible to submit their proposals who are active taxpayers as per Federal Board of Revenue Data base i.e. Active Taxpayer List (ATL) for both Income Tax & Sales Tax and relevant provincial revenue authorities/boards as the case may.
- e. Firm/JV shall have sound financial background proportional to the magnitude of work involved. Duly supported by reports, on financial standing of consultant such as balance sheets inter alia, assets and liabilities certified by an auditor along with auditor's report for last three years.

- f. Firm may engage/contract key personnel specifically for this assignment. However, consent of such key personnel for working on the assignment has to be attached with the proposal.
- g. In case of JV, Project Manager must be from the lead firm.

## 5.1 Documents Establishing Qualification of Consultant

To prove his qualification for award of Contract, Firm/JV shall provide the following information along with documentary evidence in detail:

- i. The background and experience of the firm (individual or joint venture) including authenticated list of current agreements and other supporting documents of past and present works of a nature similar to this project in the last ten years.
- ii. The detailed approach and methodology along with activity-wise time schedule proposed for carrying out the work as mentioned under the scope of work including other detailed information as deemed relevant.
- iii. The name, qualifications and professional experience of key personnel to be assigned to the project. Such key personnel shall be employed with the consultant. Documentary evidence to this effect including authentic salary slips of the key personnel shall be submitted with the proposal. Salary slips should be genuine and signed by the authorized representative of the firm as well as concerned key person.

# 6. HOUSING & OFFICE FACILITIES FOR THE CONSULTANT

- a. The Consultant shall establish their project office near the Client's office. The Construction/Resident Manager and field engineers will maintain Field Office/Camp(s) at the site(s).
- b. The Consultant shall make their own arrangements to furnish their offices. They shall provide cost estimates and details of their requirement in this respect under Direct Cost in their proposal.

#### 7. TRANSPORT
