
#### 4.1 One Bid per Bidder







- Pending litigation and No Blacklisting information: Bidder shall provide an undertaking on the Bidder's letter head that the company is not blacklisted earlier by any government agency / authority / organization. Detail of litigation pending (if any) be also provided.







Performance Security shall be, at the option of the bidder, be in the form of either (a) bank guarantee from

any scheduled bank in Pakistan or (b) bank guarantee from a bank located outside Pakistan duly counter guaranteed by a scheduled Bank in Pakistan or an insurance company having at-least AA rating from PACRA/JCR (available on NHA's approved panel), only if the quoted/evaluated bid price is upto -10% of the Engineer Estimate (EE). For such bid, the Performance Security of an amount equal to 10% of the Contract Price stated in the Letter of Acceptance in the form of Insurance Guarantee/Bank Guarantee shall be acceptable;
