

CONTRACT AGREEMENT

THIS CONTRACT AGREEMENT (hereinafter called the "Agreement") made on day of NOV 2022 between National Highway Authority (NHA) (hereafter called the "Employer") of the one part and M/s Nawab Khan & Brothers hereafter called the "Contractor") of the other part.

WHEREAS the Employer is desirous that certain Works, viz Contract No.PM-2019-20-SN-04 for Periodic Maintenance (Structural Overlay) work between Km 400+000 - 410+000 on N-55 (Shikarpur - Karampur) at the evaluated bid cost Rs.311,337,839/- (Rupees Three Hundred Eleven Million Three Hundred Thirty Seven Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty Nine only) should be executed by the Contractor and has accepted a Bid by the Contractor for the execution and completion of such Works and the remedying of any defects therein.

The construction period for the work is 178 days and defect liability period is 365 days from the date of completion.



- o) Put the "original Bid Security" in "Technical Envelope" prior to scaling it. Both sealed envelopes i.e. "Technical Envelope" and "Financial Envelope" are to be enclosed together in an outer single envelope called the hard copy of a Bid.
