The Contract KC-6B (from RD 1166 to RD 1322) of Kachhi Canal Project was awarded to M/s FWO in 2007. Due to worst law and order conditions, the Contract KC-6B was canceled and M/s FWO was released from further performance on the basis of security reasons in the area.

Total length of the Main Canal is 500 Km. The main Canal from RD 0+000 to RD 1193+000 (365 Km) has already been constructed/ completed. To complete the remaining 135 Km of Main Canal, Construction of Main Canal KC-6B(2R) from RD 1193+000 to RD 1252+000 is necessary for efficient irrigation of the remaining command area. Moreover, provision exists in the 2nd Revised PC-I which is approved by the ECNEC. Therefore, procurement was necessary to complete the remaining works of Phase-I.


THIS CONTRACT AGREEMENT (hereinafter called the "Agreement") made on the 16th day of February, 2021 between Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority (WAPDA) (hereafter called the "Employer") of the one part and M/s Ghulam Rasool & Company (Pvt.) Ltd. (hereafter called the "Contractor") of the other part.


WHEREAS the Employer is desirous that certain Works, viz CONSTRUCTION OF MAIN CANAL AND DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM (EARTH WORK, STRUCTURES AND LINING OF MAIN CANAL & DISTRIBUTARIES) FROM RD 1193 TO RD 1252 UNDER CONTRACT KC-6B(2R) OF KACHHI CANAL PROJECT should be executed by the Contractor and has accepted a Bid by the Contractor for the execution and completion of such Works and the remedying of any defects therein.

NOW this Agreement witnesseth as follows:


1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract hereinafter referred to.
2. The following documents after incorporating addenda, if any, except those parts relating to Instructions to Bidders shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as part of this Agreement, viz:

The Employer hereby covenants to pay the Contractor, in consideration of the execution and completion of the Works as per provisions of the Contract, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of the Contract at the times and in the manner prescribed by the Contract.
