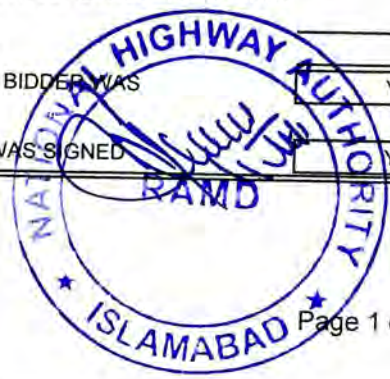

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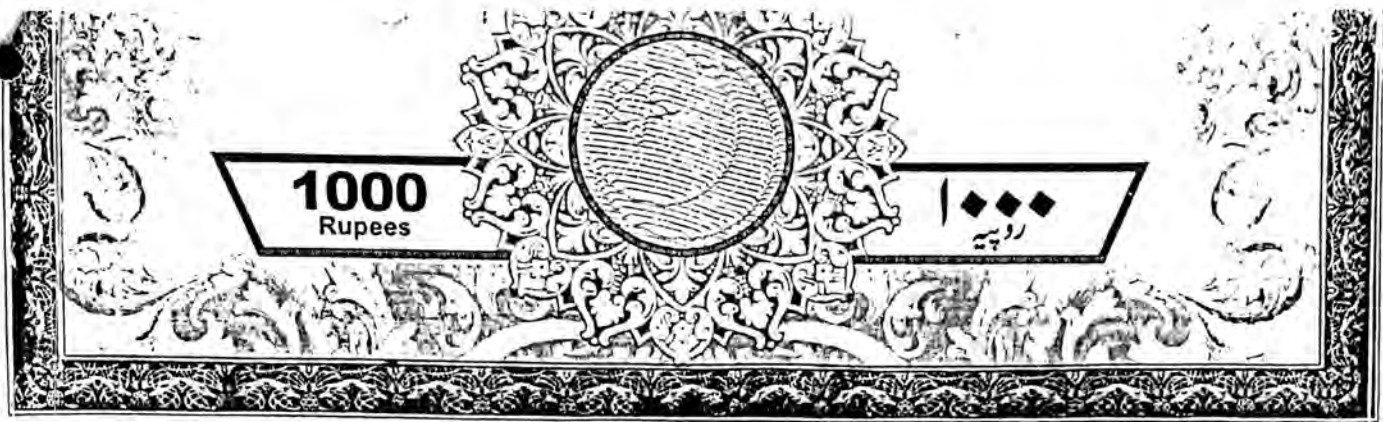

THIS CONTRACT AGREEMENT (hereinafter called the "Agreement") made on the day of June 2022 between National Highway Authority (NHA) (hereafter called the "Employer") of the one part and M/s Abdul Hakim Khan & Sons (Pvt) Ltd. hereafter called the "Contractor") of the other part.

WHEREAS the Employer is desirous that certain Works, viz Contract No.PS-M1-20-3001 for Periodic Maintenance Work (Structural Overlay) between Km 420 – 460 (NBC/SBC) on M-1 at the bid cost Rs.471,848,671/- (Rupees Four Hundred Seventy One Million Eight Hundred Forty Eight Thousand Six Hundred and Seventy One only) should be executed by the Contractor and has accepted a Bid by the Contractor for the execution and completion of such Works and the remedying of any defects therein.

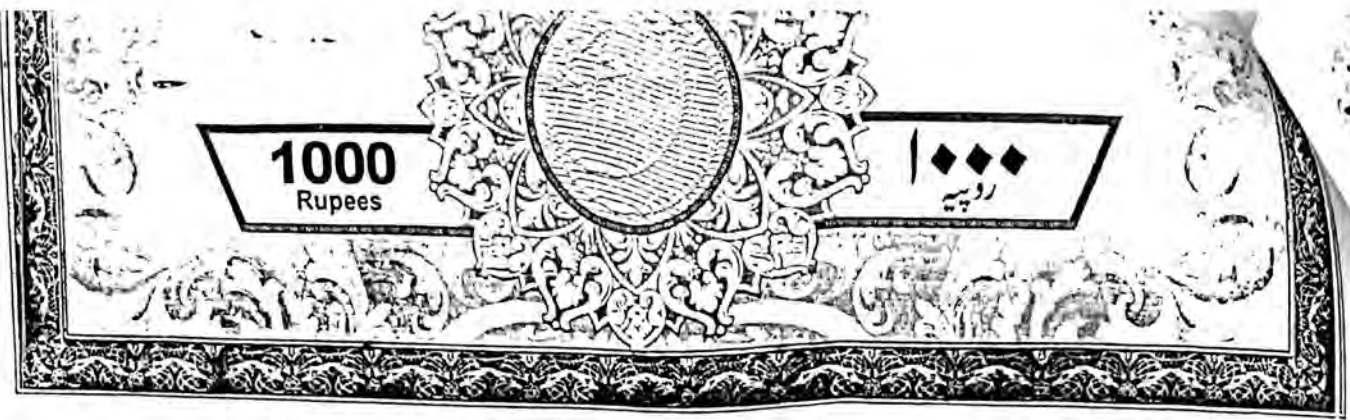
NOW this Agreement witnesseth as follows:

1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract hereinafter referred to.

3. In consideration of the payments to be made by the Employer to the Contractor as hereinafter mentioned, the Contractor hereby covenants with the Employer to execute and complete the Works and remedy any defects therein in conformity and in all respects with the provisions of the Contract.
4. The Employer hereby covenants to pay the Contractor, in consideration of the execution and completion of the Works and remedying any defects therein as per provisions of the Contract, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of the Contract at the times and in the manner prescribed in the Contract. The construction period for the work is 178 days and defect liability period is 365 days from the date of completion.



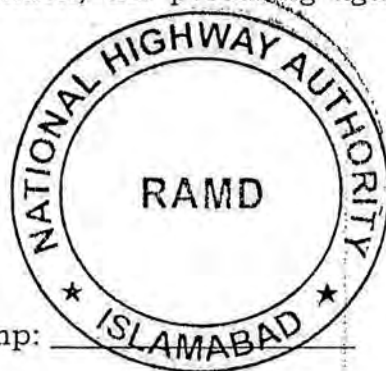

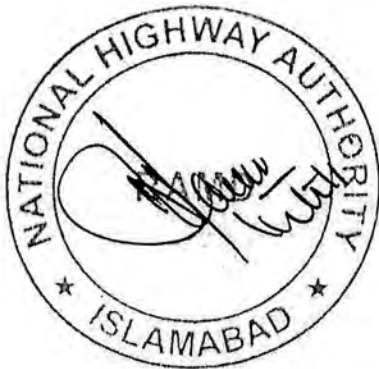

 - iv) Firm that has a minimum Average Working Capital of Rs. 46 Million based on the last three years (2018-19, 2019 -20 and 2020 -21) audit reports. *(Audit Reports are must to be provided).*
 - v) Firm that has the capacity to generate minimum Cash Flow of Rs.227 Million, based on the last three years (2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020 -21) audit reports. *(Audit Reports are must to be provided).*
 - vi) Firms with satisfactory Past or present performance with NHA or any other executing agency and that have not been blacklisted earlier by any government agency/ authority / organization.

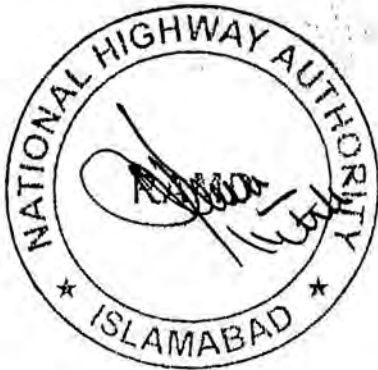


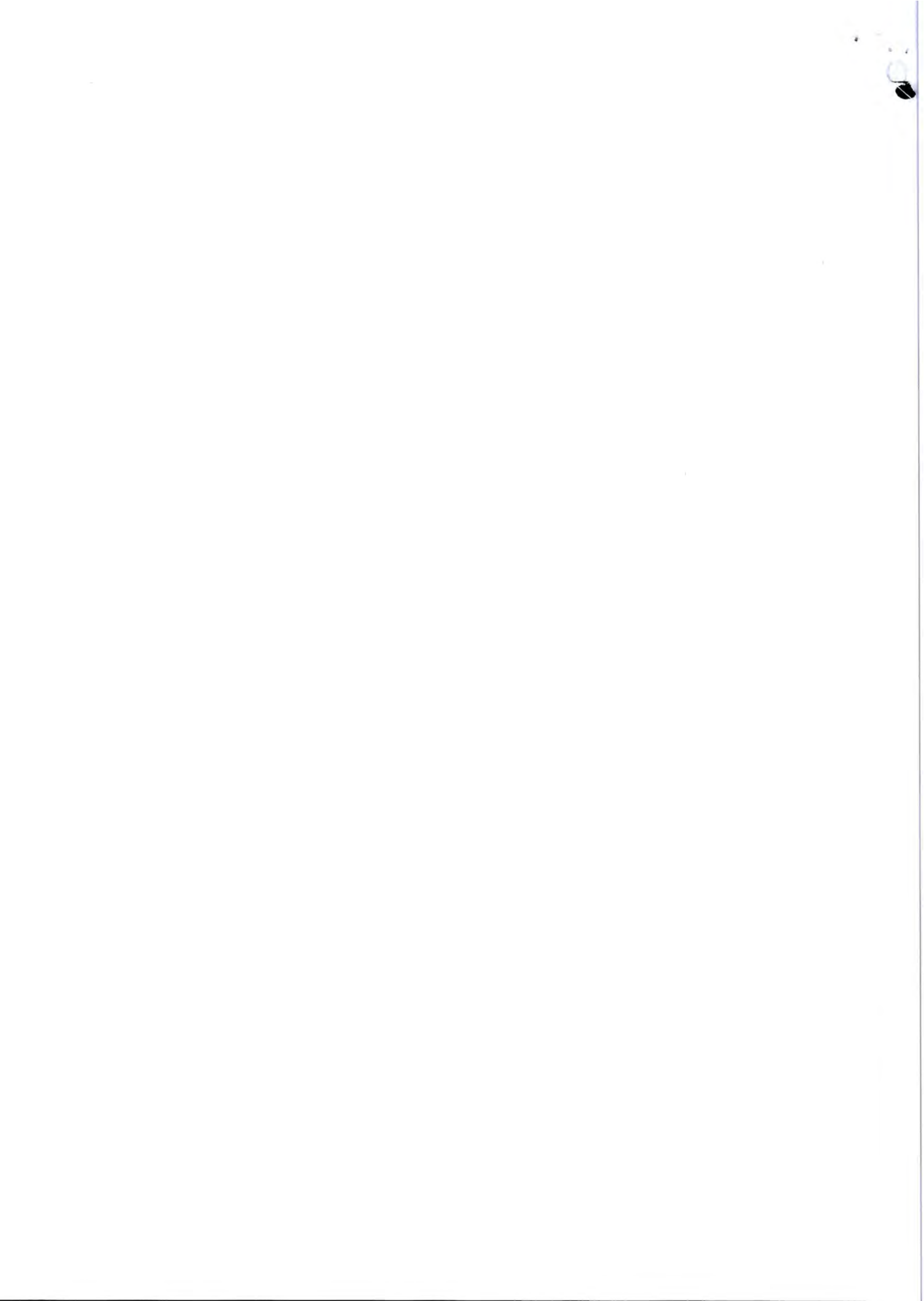
