ii) Has an Average Annual Construction Turnover of minimum **Rs. 820.00 Million** for last three years. In case of JV each partner must fulfill the Criteria with respect to its share in the JV Agreement.

iii) Has a minimum Cash Flow of **Rs. 205.00 Million** (Average of last three years). In case of JV each partner must fulfill the Criteria with respect to its share in the JV Agreement.

iv) Has a minimum Net Working Capital for the latest year of **Rs. 41.00 Million** (Average of last three years). In case of JV each partner must fulfill the Criteria with respect to its share in the JV Agreement.

v) Past or present performance of the bidder as contractor (individual or all partners of a JV) is satisfactory with NHA or any other executing agency and the contractor has not been blacklisted earlier by any government agency / authority / organization.

The Bid must accompany a Power of Attorney issued by authorized representative of the Firm / Company / (for all partners of a JV) having the name and CNIC No. of the person to whom Power of Attorney has been issued to submit the bid to the Employer on behalf of the Firm / Company / JV etc.

ii. Written confirmation (Power of Attorney) authorizing the signatory of the Bid to commit the Bidder

Original Power of Attorney on Judicial Stamp Paper duly attested by Notary Public with original signatures to sign/commit the bid on following format must accompany the bid:

- The person issuing authority of Power of Attorney shall provide the legal documents establishing his / her authority of issuing the Power of Attorney on behalf of Firm / Company / (for all partners of JV);

- c. The authorized representative and the Project Manager will be from the lead partner having greater % or above share in JV.
- d. The JV partners clearly define the type, extent, quantum and proportionate of resources to be mobilized by each partner to ensure subsequent mobilization of resources at site which should be in accordance with JV share.

vii. List of Major Equipment – Related Items

The Bidder shall provide a list of all major equipment and related items owned, to be purchased or to be leased by the bidder in carrying out the work in on judicial Stamp Paper according to **Appendix-G to Bid**.

Bidders shall list down the equipments which **must** support the construction schedule.

vii. Past Performance/ Experience

**General Construction Experience:** Experience under construction contracts in the role of Contractor, Subcontractor or Management Contractor for at least the last ten (10) years prior to the bid submission deadline as per **Appendix – N** to Bid.

**12.3 Bid Prices**

Add following at the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph:

“However, increase / decrease in Income Tax is not covered in this clause.”

**13.1 Currencies of Bid and Payment**

The unit rates and prices shall be quoted by the bidder entirely in Pak Rupees and will be paid in Pak Rupees only.

**14.1 Period of Bid Validity**

Bid shall remain valid and open for acceptance for a period of **One Hundred and Eighty (180)** calendar days after the latest dead line for submission of bid.

**15.1 Amount of Bid Security**

The amount of Bid Security shall be **Rs. 8.2 Million**. In case of non-registered JV, either each partner gives bid security equal to his share or the lead partner / major shareholder provides bid security for all.

**15.2 Form and Validity of Bid Security**

The Bid Security shall be, at the option of the bidder, in the form of **Deposit at Call** or a **Bank Guarantee** issued by a Scheduled Bank in Pakistan or from a foreign bank duly counter guaranteed by a Scheduled Bank in Pakistan or an **insurance company** having atleast AA rating from PACRA/JCR in favour of the Employer valid for a period 28 days beyond the Bid Validity date i.e the Bid Security shall remain valid for **208 days (Two Hundred & Eight)** calendar days beyond the latest deadline for submission of Bids.
