> NEED ANALYSIS (Why the procurement was necessary?)

Central Directorate of National Savings (CDNS) is an attached department of the Finance Division, with a vision to "promote and inculcate the value of thrift for mobilization of savings" and a mission to "be the preferred institution for small savers to facilitate objective of financial inclusion".

Following are the core objectives of the CDNS:

- a) Inculcate the habit of thrift among masses.
- b) Provide secure deposit avenues to small savers thus contributing towards the goal of financial inclusion.
- c) Provide a safety net to special segments of society like widows, senior citizens (60 years and above) and retired Government Servants in the absence of effective social security system.
- d) Channelize the un-conventional savings to the financial system.
- e) Assist the Government in policy formulation regarding Savings.
- f) Provide non-inflationary non0bank borrowing to the Government to bridge overall fiscal deficit (OFD).

<u>CDNS is a premier financial institution offering retail Government Securities</u> and Savings Products (known as National Savings Schemes (NSS)), level playing field to small savers through diversified product mix. It is a key contributor towards financial inclusion with an investor base of around 7 Million and portfolio of over PKR 3300 Billion, which is around 33% of the total Banking deposits, Its share in domestic debt of Government is around 24%. Most of its products are designed for low-income segments of the society, however due to IT and Operational constraints; it is unable to play its role to extend financial services to the low-income segments. At present, NSS are being offered through a network of 375 National Savings Centers (NSCs).

<u>Technology upgrade and improvement of Central Directorate of National Savings'</u> <u>Accounting/Financial Business Software Application backed by Oracle Database (Main Application Software) was essential for provision of reliable and secure technology platforms that enable CDNS and its business to offer its customers a vast array of payment types, across multiple channels, anywhere at any time using centralized architecture, shifting from distributed one, through; "Technology Up-gradation & Support Services of Existing Business Software Solution/System".</u>

Central Directorate of National Savings has its own Main Application Software which was designed and developed in 2003-05 & 2007-08 respectively. While the application sufficed the requirements for several years, new tools and technologies of ICT, especially in the context of smart way of doing financial business, warrant a relook at its usage and upgrade to make it competitive with prevailing modern financial business solutions.

Following were the issues and challenges with existing "Main Application Software" of Central Directorate of National Savings":

- i. Application is outdated technology.
- ii. Application has no capability to incorporate new products.
- iii. Every branch is equipped with heavy system resources.
- iv. No Centralized transaction/reporting and business intelligence system.
- v. No control of User Management at Branch level and of course at Centralized level.
- vi. Have no provision with NADRA for verification of CNIC/CRC/NICOP.
- vii. No support and maintenance available.
- viii. In case of disaster at any branch have no proper mechanism for recovery (Data, Application, Setup/Configuration etc. in short Disaster Recovery).
- ix. Present Application has no control to stop redundancy etc.
- x. No Centralized back-up Solution.
- xi. No Centralized Restoration Solution.
- xii. No Database Performance Tuning Mechanism.
- xiii. No Monitoring System.
- xiv. No Auditing System.
- xv. Huge IT and other Resources required at every region.

Besides addressing the above referred shortcomings, CDNS, intends the following deliverables from the subject Contract:

- i. Technology Up-gradation of existing "Main Application Software" to be compatible and infrastructure to meet all business requirements.
- ii. Centralization and DR Database Servers through robust and available centralized architecture with maximum flexibility and platform independency.
- iii. Capable to handle all risks of Data redundancies.
- iv. Support, Maintenance, Updates and other related technical Services for the tenure of Five (05) years for upgraded "Main Application Software".
- v. Improve User Experience.
- vi. A Project Plan to manage the upgrade, consolidation, Data migration and configuration management with changes associated with Reason Codes.
- vii. To achieve all targets to meet with CDNS business requirements.
