SECTION - II: Terms & Conditions

- 1) The bids will be governed by Single stage One envelope procedure.
- 2) The last date for submission of bids is on or before 24 June 2024, 1300 hrs (Toronto Local Time) either through personal delivery or registered post/courier.
- 3) The Bid Opening Committee will open the bids on 24 June 2024 at 1330 hrs in the presence of bidders or their representatives, who may choose to be present either physically.
