The Islamic Republic of Afghanistan has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Ez-Kar Project, Component 1, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for **IT and Network Equipment's for Pakistan (Quetta, Peshawar, Karachi and Islamabad) in Four Lots**
2. The **Ministry of Foreign Affairs** now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for Procurement of **IT and Network Equipment's for Pakistan (Quetta, Peshawar, Karachi and Islamabad) in Four Lots**.
3. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" **July 2016 Revised in November 2017** ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from Ez-Kar Project Component 1, Mr. Sher Mohammad Seddeqi, s.seddeqi@mfa.af and inspect the bidding document during office hours 09:00 to 15:00 hours at the address given below.
5. The bidding document in English may be obtained by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **December 21, 2020 at 10:30 am Islamabad Local Time**. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on the mentioned date and time.
7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security:

For the Lot#1: USD 846 (Eight Hundred Forty-Six US Dollar)

For the Lot#2: USD 870 (Eight Hundred Seventy US Dollar)

For the Lot#3: USD 424 (Four Hundred Twenty-Four US Dollar)

For the Lot#4: USD 460 (Four Hundred Sixty US Dollar)

Bidder may choose to bid for one or all four (4) lots, evaluation and award will be on basis of lots.

If the bidder wishes to qualify for award of the contract for four lots then, the bidder must demonstrate having minimum amount of Bid Security to meet the aggregate of the qualifying criteria for the individual lots and with the total amount of USD 2,600 (Two Thousand Six Hundred) for the Four Lots.
