For Disposal of Waste / Used Papers

Bids are invited from the firms / vendors / contractors for disposal of old / used papers. The waste papers can be seen during official working hours on or before the closing date of bidding process i.e. **17th February, 2025 (Monday)**. Detail of approximate quantity of old/waste papers of various categories are as under:

BIDDING DOCUMENT

For Disposal of Waste / Used Papers

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Bid invitation notice, terms & conditions and bid submission proforma for disposal of waste papers is available on PPRA website (www.ppra.org.pk) and FPSC website (www.fpsc.gov.pk).
2. Eligible Firm / Vendor / Bidder fulfilling the following eligibility criteria shall quote rates in Pak Rupees for above items per kilogram (without applicable taxes) on the bid submission proforma and must submit the following documents before the closing time for submission of bid in the office of Director (Logistics), FPSC to confirm the eligibility of the firm/bidder:
 - a. Bidder shall be on the active tax payer list of FBR.
 - b. Bidder have the past experience of lifting of waste papers worth Rs.10 million for each year during the last two financial years from Government / Semi Government Departments. For proof bidder shall provide the work orders / proof of deposit of money worth Rs.10 million against the similar activity in SBP / NBP during last two financial years i.e. 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 and tax deposited against the activities in SBP/NBP.
 - c. Satisfactory Performance Certificate from at least two Government/Semi Government Department regarding disposal of waste papers showing cost of work order.
 - d. Provide the bid security @ Rs.10% of the quoted bid value in the shape of CDR / Bank Draft / Pay Order refundable drawn on the name of Federal Public Service Commission FTN No.9010202-9 in the office of Director (Logistics), FPSC before closing time of bid submission. Cheque / Cash shall not be accepted as bid security, in any case.
 - e. The bidder shall not be black listed from any Government Department / Organization at the time of submission of bid.
3. Bidders along with submitting Security Deposit (in original) shall provide an affidavit on Rs.100/- stamp paper (in original) before the closing time for submission of bid that the firm/bidder has not been black listed from any Government Department / Organization at the time of submission of Bid and fulfills the aforementioned eligibility criteria to participate in the bidding process.
4. All applicable taxes shall be deposited by the successful bidder in addition to quoted rates per KG for various categories of papers in the SBP / NBP as per policy of FBR.
5. The successful bidder shall install the heavy-duty shredder / paper cutter at FPSC HQs, F-5/1, Aga Khan Road, Islamabad and shred the papers in at least four pieces before lifting the waste papers from FPSC HQs for re-cycling.
6. Validity of the quoted bid price is till June 30, 2025.
7. The bid security of successful bidders shall be retained as Performance Guarantee and will be released after completion of the work satisfactorily.
8. Bid Security of unsuccessful bidder shall be returned on the same day.

9. Performance guarantee shall be forfeited, if the qualifier bidder fails to lift the waste papers within the bid validity period as per prescribed procedure.
10. Over written bids shall be rejected and treated as non-responsive bid.
11. Award of contract shall be awarded to the highest and most advantageous bidder based on highest combined rates for the whole activity, once bidder submitted the bid in the tender box shall not be allowed to withdraw the submitted bid at any cost. Firm/bidder shall be responsible to lift all items, firm/bidder who will not quote the rate/bid against any item shall be disqualified from the bidding process.
12. Sealed bids shall be dropped in a sealed tender box in the office of Director (Logistics), Room No.14, FPSC HQs, F-5/1, Aga Khan Road, Islamabad on the closing date i.e. 17th February, 2025 (Monday) at 11:30 AM, the submitted bids shall be opened on the same day at 12:30 pm in presence of bidder(s).
13. On issuance of work order, successful bidders shall provide the affidavit on stamp paper worth Rs.100/- that the information contained in the waste papers shall not be disclosed by any way and the waste papers shall only be used for the purpose of re-cycling.
14. Vendor shall arrange his own truck for transportation of waste papers and weight thereof under the Supervision of designated team from FPSC i.e. Assistant Director (Log-I / III) and Security Supervisor. Loaded truck shall not be allowed to exit without submission of Gate Pass at the outer gate of FPSC HQs., the Gate Pass shall be signed by Assistant Director (Log-I / III) and Security Supervisor.
15. **Firm/bidder who will not quote the rate / bid against any item shall be disqualified from the bidding process. The firm / bidder who quote the highest bid in whole and fulfill the eligibility criteria shall be considered as successful and most advantageous bidder, However, actual rates shall be calculated item wise due to variation in actual weight of various items / categories of waste / used papers.**
16. **All old/used/waste papers shall be transported from fourth floor of FPSC HQs to ground floor by the bidder with his own labor and make the pieces with heavy duty paper shredder / paper cutter at the designated place at FPSC premises in the Supervision of Incharge Record Section (FPSC) and Security Supervisor (FPSC) and ensure the disposal of papers in shredded pieces to maintain secrecy of classified papers in all respects.**
17. FPSC reserves the right to increase / decrease the estimated quantity of waste papers.
18. FPSC reserves the right to reject all bids at any time prior to acceptance of bids as per rule 33 (1) of PPRA Rules, 2004
