



Invitation for Prequalification

1. The National Highways & Motorway Police (NHMP), Motorway Central-II Zone, Multan invites sealed prequalification proposals from firms/vendors registered with relevant Taxation Departments, are listed on the Active Taxpayers List of FBR/PRA for supply of miscellaneous road safety awareness items and provision of event management services, and are registered with PPRA for e-Procurement on EPADS (www.eprocure.gov.pk).

2. **Objective of Prequalification:** This invitation is for prequalification of firms/vendors for the purchase of miscellaneous road safety awareness items (Pamphlets, Banners, Stickers, Standees, Gift Hamper Packages, Souvenir Shields, Booklets etc.) and provision of event management services to the Zonal Office and Sector-I M-5 of NHMP, MC-II Zone, Multan.

3. **Prequalification Process:** The prequalification process aims to establish Open Framework Agreement(s) for a period of three years, from Financial Year 2024-25 to 2026-27, under PPRA Rules-2004. Only prequalified applicants will be entitled to participate in the procurement proceedings. The selected bidders will sign the open framework agreement(s) with NHMP.

4. **Prequalification Documents:** Prequalification documents are available at the websites of NHMP (www.nhmp.gov.pk), and EPADS (www.eprocure.gov.pk) free of cost OR can be obtained from the Office of the DIG/Zonal Commander Office, NHMP Motorway Central-II Zone, Multan Located at Bahawalpur Bypass Chowk Qasim Pur Road Near Rasheed Avenue Total Pump Multan during office hours before the closing date, on the payment of Pak Rupees One thousand (PKR=1000) in the form of Pay Order in the name of "Road Safety Fund (NHMP) M5 Zone, Multan" which is non-refundable.

5. **Proposal Submission:** Proposals/Bids must be submitted online through **EPADS** at (www.eprocure.gov.pk) before the opening date and original bids/proposals must be submitted at the aforementioned office by 11:00 hours on or before **22-11-2024**, the bids/proposals will be opened on the same day at 11:30 hours at the aforementioned office.

6. **Bid Security:** Each proposal/bid must be accompanied by a bid security of Rs.60,000/- (refundable) or Rs.30,000/- (if participating in one category as mentioned in PDS clause No.11 at page # 23) in the form of a Bank Draft/CDR in the name of "Road Safety Fund (NHMP) M5 Zone, Multan". Moreover, this bid security deposit of successful applicants shall remain with this department which will be refunded on expiry of the contract/agreement only. Applications without Security Deposit will be rejected.

7. NHMP reserves the right to reject any or all bids prior to acceptance. In case the opening date is declared a public holiday, the next working day shall be deemed the submission and opening date.
