- g) A non-conforming tender is one, which does not satisfy the above requirements and it may be rejected.

12. Award of Contract

12.1. Qualification

12.1.1. In the absence of prequalification, the PA will determine to its satisfaction whether the Bidder that is selected after technical scoring/evaluation as having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive bid is qualified to perform the contract satisfactorily.

12.1.2. The determination will take into account the Bidder's compliance with the qualification criteria defined in the bidding document.

12.1.3. The PA will award the contract to the successful Bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive (after mandatory and technical evaluation criteria) and has been determined to be the lowest evaluated bid, provided further that the Bidder is determined to be qualified to perform the contract satisfactorily.

12.2. PA's Right to Increase or Decrease Quantities at the time of Award. The PA reserves the right at the time of contract award to increase or decrease, by the percentage indicated in the Bid Data Sheet, the quantity of goods and services originally specified in the Schedule of Requirements without any change in unit price or other terms and conditions.

12.3. PA's Right to Accept any Bid and to Reject any or All Bids

12.3.1. The PA reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or bidders. The PA will inform the affected Bidder or bidders of the grounds for the PA's action, if so, requested by, but the PA shall not be bound to justify the grounds.

12.3.2. The PA can disqualify any successful bidder at any time prior to or even after the award of the contract, if he was found indulged in Corrupt or Fraudulent practices commonly understood as unethical or being defined in PPR-2004 and other provincial procurement rules.
