2. Before the meeting, briefing was given to Director (P&D) that Ministry of National Health Services, Regulation and Coordination invited sealed bids from interested firms for the Tender No. F.NO 1-19/2019-(P&D) /TS554531E advertised on 5<sup>th</sup> Jan, 2025 in national newspapers for the "Provision Of Utilities For Training Models And Maintenance Services For Nursing Program", based on PPRA Rule 6 (2)(b) "Single Stage, Two Envelope Procedure" with bid submission date as 22-01-2025 11:30.

3. Six (**03**) bidders offered their Bid Proposal and bids were opened on 22-01-2025 at 11:00 AM by the Technical Committee in presence of representatives of participating bidders.

4. The evaluation criteria comprised of two stages. After going through the bids proposals and the clarification sought from the bidders afterwards, following is the assessment of the Technical Committee about each of the participating bidders.

6. The Procurement/purchase Committee recommended that **EMQ Technologies** being lowest evaluated bidder as per Rule 36(b) of PPRA Rules based on the principles of transparency, economy, efficiency and value for money enshrined in rule 4 of the Public Procurement rules, 2004.

7. The Procurement / Purchase Committee recommended to award the contract to the lowest evaluated bidder i.e **EMQ Technologies**, after fulfillment of all codal formalities of Public Procurement Rules, 2004. Bid Marks were given to only technically successful bidders. The bid amount of successful companies were thoroughly checked by the committee and it was found that the attached earnest money is more than the amount of 2% required.

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

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

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
