At 1<sup>st</sup> step, the evaluation of tender bids has been undertaken based on the general eligibility of the firms and the quotations/bids offered by the bidder against the technical specifications invited in the tender documents.

#### **Technical Evaluation:**

The initial advertisement for the tender F.2-11(3)/2019-20/FPMU containing lab renovation and installation of Fabricated sheds (12 Nos.) was floated on 02-12-2019 with bid opening date of 19-12-2019 .No firm submitted bid document for the evaluation. The tender was re-advertised, due to non-participation of bidding firms. In the re-tender the technical bid was opened on 13<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2020 and it was participated by four (04) firms. One of the firm Capital

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engineering services, Islamabad was found to be non-compliant due to lack of documentation i.e affidavit for blacklisting and current banking statement missing. All other three firms M/s United Business Group Islamabad, M/s Muhammad Ayub Khan Islamabad and M/s Javed Sons & brothers Islamabad were found technically compliant both in documentation and technical specification.

### Financial Evaluation Criteria:

The financial bid was opened on 31<sup>st</sup> day of January 2020 and it was declared that United Business Group Islamabad gave the lowest bid amounting to Rs: **Rs.20,551,693.32/-** and hence was found to be first lowest amongst three. The financial bids of M/s Javed Sons & Brothers and M/s Muhammad Ayub Khan were rejected on the grounds of non-inclusion of GST.
