M/s ADR ODR International meets the mandatory requirements and has obtained 52.5 marks and is declared technically qualified on the basis of eligibility criteria, i.e. minimum 36 marks (60% of 60 marks). Therefore, the Procurement Committee recommends opening the financial bid of technically qualified firm, i.e. M/s ADR ODR International.
