- No alteration is to be made in the Letters of Price and Technical Bids nor in the Appendices thereto except in filling up the blanks as directed. If any such alterations be made or if these instructions be not fully complied with, the bid may be rejected.
- The Bidder shall prepare one original of the Technical Bid and one original of the Price Bid comprising the Bid as described in Bidding Data Sheet against IB 11 and clearly mark it "ORIGINAL TECHNICAL BID" and "ORIGINAL PRICE BID". In addition, the Bidder shall submit **two (2) copies** of the Bid and clearly mark each of them "COPY." In the event of any discrepancy between the original and the copies, the original shall prevail.
- The original and all copies of the Bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Bidder. This authorization shall consist of a written confirmation as specified in the Bidding Data Sheet and shall be attached to the bid. The name and position held by each person signing the authorization must be typed or printed below the signature. All pages of the Bid, except for un-amended printed literature, shall be signed or initialed by the person signing the bid.
- 18.6 Any amendments such as interlineations, erasures, or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by the person signing the bid.
- 18.7 Bidders shall indicate in the space provided in the Letter of Technical and Price Bids, their full and proper addresses at which notices may be legally served on them and to which all correspondence in connection with their bids and the Contract is to be sent.
- 18.8 Bidders should retain a copy of the Bidding Documents as their file copy.

IB.19 Sealing and Marking of Bids

- 19.1 Each bidder shall submit his bid as under:
 - (a) ORIGINAL and each copy of the Bid shall be separately sealed and put in separate envelopes and marked as such.
 - (b) The envelopes containing the ORIGINAL and copies will be put in one sealed envelope and addressed / identified as given in IB 19.2 hereof.
 - (c) The technical bid should comprise of documents listed in IB11.1 (A) & the price bid should comprise of documents listed in IB 11.1 (B) which shall be placed in separate envelopes in accordance with IB 11.1.

12.3 Bid Prices

Add following at the end of 2nd paragraph:

"Increse in rate of income tax is not covered under cluse 70.2 of conditions of contarct, and the cost of risk of increse in rate of income tax is to be bulit is in the quoted bid amount. However, the contract amount shall be adjusted if exempution in income tax or decrese in rate of income tax is granted after the date twenty eight (28) days prior to the latest date for submission of bids"

13.1 Currencies of Bid and Payment

The prices evaluated by incorporating the "% rebate or % premium quoted by the bidder" shall be entirely in Pak Rupees and will be paid in Pak Rupees only.

14.1 Period of Bid Validity

Bid shall remain valid and open for acceptance for a period of **One Hundred and Fifty** (150) calendar days after the latest dead line for submission of bid.

15.1 Amount of Bid Security

The amount of Bid Security shall be Rs. 4.00 Million In case of non-registered JV, either each partner gives bid security equal to his share or the lead partner / major shareholder provides bid security for all.

15.2 Form and Validity of Bid Security

The Bid Security shall be, at the option of the bidder, in the form of Deposit at Call or a Bank Guarantee issued by a Scheduled Bank in Pakistan or from a foreign bank duly counter guaranteed by a Scheduled Bank in Pakistan in favour of the Employer (GM Maintenance KP, NHA Peshawar) valid for a period of 28 days beyond the Bid validity date i.e. the Bid Security shall remain valid for 178 days (One Hundred & Seventy Eight) calendar days beyond the latest deadline for submission of Bids.

18.4 Number of Copies of the Bid to be Completed and Returned

Bidders will submit the bid as described in BDS sheet 11.1 above. Number of copies of Technical Bid and Price Bid will be as under:

- a. e-Bid submitted as per BDS clause 11.1.
- b. One hard copy (ORIGINAL) of e-Bid as per clause 11.1.
