# MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE DEPARTMENTAL TENDER COMMITTEE HELD ON 22-12-2020 IN THE COMMITTEE ROOM OF THE ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT, KPT.

## NAME OF WORK:- RE-HABILITATION OF RAIL TRACKS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS AT EAST & WEST WHARVES KPT (PHASE-I)

- As per direction issued in the meeting held on the KPT Head Office on 15-02-2019 between Minister
  of Maritime Affairs and Minister of Railways, survey was carried out of the KPT Rail Tracks within
  Port Limit.
- 2. After detailed survey and threadbare discussion, out of 33 KM KPT Rail Track Network. About 11.0 KM Rail Track at East / West Wharves were identified, by the team comprising of KPT and PR Engineers / Officials, to be in dilapidated condition and requiring re-habilitation. The work was divided in several projects spanning over 03 years in phases so that the Cargo Handling by PR may not be hurdled.
- 3. As per the directions of Competent Authority, joint visits alongwith the officials of Pakistan Railways Karachi Office were carried out to ascertain the condition of Rail Tracks within KPT Limit in Phase-I. Accordingly following four (04) Nos. Projects which is 2.9 KM were considered to be undertaken, hence same were initiated and floated by the Civil Works Department.
  - Re-habilitation of Track No. 17 1st (Remaining 660Track Meter at East Wharf Phase-II.
  - Re-habilitation of Rail Tracks at Gate No. 36 West Wharf. (900 Track Feet Two Number Tracks And Cross Overs)
  - Laying of Two Nos. Cross over at Table side in from of Berth No. 14 to 16 to facilitate Freight Movement at East Wharf. (400 R. Track Meter. And Cross Overs)
  - Re-habilitation of Track No. 13 at Marshalling Yard West Wharf. (3170 R. Track Feet)
- 4. The first two tenders were called on 26-02-2020 and the next two tenders were advertised on 20-04-2020 and later on Corrigendum was advertised on 08-05-2020 for extension in date of submission due to COVID-19 and finally tenders received on 03-06-2020.
- 5. In the meanwhile Federal Audit observed and directed that rather than splitting the work into piecemeal of similar nature of projects, a consolidated projects of all similar nature works to be called as single tender. Therefore it was decided by the Competent Authority that all the above four tenders be combined in one single tender and may floated on emergent basis in collaboration with the representatives of Pakistan Railways staff.

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- 6. Thereafter several joint visits of tracks were again carried out by the Civil Works Department officers and Pakistan Railways Officials and the estimate was revisited for the comprehensive revised consolidated estimate for the Projects as already proposed in the joint project allocation of the Re-habilitation of the Rail Tracks.
- Technical & Financial Proposal for the above work were invited by the Chief Engineer KPT under Rule No. 36 (b) of PPRA through Press, KPT, MoMA & PPRA Websites on 01-10-2020.
- In response One Firm has submitted his sealed Technical / Financial Proposals on 17-11-2020 as per the Advertisement.
- 9. The Technical Proposals were opened on 17-11-2020 in the presence of the Committee Members their representative viz;

- 11. The Technical Evaluation Criteria of the bidders as mentioned in the Advertisement is as follows:

  - Updated Company Profile.

  - · Financial Stability Statement from Banker for the two years.
  - Relevant Work Experience (at least 02 completed Projects).

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- 12. After due diligence, the committee submitted its detail report placed at S.No.10.
- 13. As per the report of in-house committee M/s. NLC Engineers stand qualified in the Technical Evaluation.
- 14. The DTC Committee recommends the Technical Evaluation Report of the in-house committee & their recommendations therefore Chairman sanction was requested for opening of the Financial Proposal of the Technically Qualified bidder.
- Accordingly the Chairman's approval was obtained on the report of DTC for opening of Financial Proposal of qualified bidder on 27-11-2020 (PP-16).
- 16. The Financial Proposal for the qualified bidder was opened on 08-12-2020 and tabulated as follows:

- 18. The Committee evaluated the financial Proposal and went through the items in details of M/s NLC and inferred that the bid is responsive except for the slight correction that M/s NLC had quoted Contingencies as 2.5%, which has been corrected by the Comptist, and the bid price of Rs. 228,832,128.90 ( Two Hundred and Twenty Eight Million Eight Hundred and Thirty Two Thousands One Hundred and Twenty Eight Rupees and Ninety Paisas) was corrected as to be Rs. Rs.234,413,400.34 (Rupees: Two Hundred Thirty Four Million Four Hundred Thirteen Thousand Four Hundred Rupees & Thirty Four Paisa Only)
- 19. The summarized outcome of the Evaluation of Financial Bids is as under:

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- 20. It is to mention here that, in the initial estimates prepared for the first two projects as mentioned in Para - 3, the rates were taken as per Pakistan Railways Schedule of Rates. However the bids had come almost 24% below. Hence in the later two projects and in the current project in which all the items are of similar nature. The rates were revised in the light of the bidders' rate of the tenders received on 26-02-2020. Considering the above, the rates of NLC Engineers which are almost 49.62 % above as per current Engineer's Estimate prepared on the basis of Contractor bid rates for earlier tender for the individual works. However, NLC Engineer rates are 12.71 % above the rates of Engineer's Estimate based on Pakistan Railways Schedule of Rates which amounts to Rs. 205.39 (M) approx.
- 21. Keeping in view of their past performance as mentioned in item (m) above, M/s. NLC Engineers may be considered for carrying out this work.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

The lowest offer amounting to Rs.234,413,400.34 (Rupees: Two Hundred Thirty Four Million Four Hundred Thirteen Thousand Four Hundred & Thirty Four Only) received from M/s. NLC Engineers is as under:

- a) 49.62 % above current Engineer's Estimate prepared on the basis of Contractor bid rates for earlier tender for the individual works (as intimated in Para – 3 above)
- b) 12.17 % above the rates of Engineer's Estimate based on Pakistan Railways Schedule of Rates 2013 (Amended 2019-20).

Keeping in view of their past performance as mentioned in item (m) above, M/s. NLC Engineers is considered for carrying out this work.

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The Committee after going through the Financial Evaluation Report of the in-house committee and their recommendation, recommends the acceptance of the single lowest quoted bid amounting Rs.234,413,400.34 (Rupees: Two Hundred Thirty Four Million Four Hundred Thirteen Thousand Four Hundred Rupees & Thirty Four Paisa Only) received from M/s. NLC Engineers, for this work on the basis of Estimate based on Pakistan Railways Schedule of Rates 2013 (Amended 2019-20)
