CO PNCSD may order 15% of contracted quantity against DPL-15 to meet urgent/critical requirement, under intimation to CINS, the firm is required to deliver/supplies within 45 days against receipt of such order, liquidated damages (LD) upto 2% per month are liable to be imposed on the supplier in accordance with DP-35 for late delivery of stores without any valid reason.
