	 The Purchaser may not claim LD in relation to delays in delivery, provided that such delays have been caused by occurrence of a force-majeure event.
21.	PRICE VARIATION. Prices in the schedule of stores of the contract are firm and final. The stores must be of brand new manufacture not older than 01 x year at the time of delivery.
22.	PENALTY. The Seller before making the shipment will carry out complete test of the equipment at its facilities to ensure that the same has been manufactured as per specifications. In case the equipment does not puss the test/trails, the buyer has the right to out rightly reject the equipment of impose penalty at the rate of 2-5% of the value of the relevant equipment/items. The penalty shall not absolve the seller to undertake the repairs in Pakistan or on board at his cost and expense including freight charges. This shall be in addition to the penalties and obligations epvered in the contract like warranty/guarantee obligations on Form DPL-15.
23.	DISCREPANCY. The consignee will render a discrepancy report to all concerned within 30 days after receipt of stores for discrepancies found in the consignment. The quantities found short are to be made good by the supplier, without any additional cost within 30 days.
24.	TSR. TSR of the case will be carried out by a committee nominated by NHQ.
25.	ARBITRATION. Parties shall make their attempt to settle all disputes arising under this contract through friendly discussions in good faith. In the event that either party shall perceive such friendly discussion to be making insufficient progress towards settlement of dispute at any time, then such party may by written notice to the other party refer the dispute(s) to final and binding arbitration as provided below:
	a. Should the Supplier fail to deliver goods/services in time as per terms of contract or fail to render Bank Guarantee within the stipulated time period or any breach of the contract the Purchaser reserves the right to terminate/cancel the contract fully or any part thereof at the risk and expense (RE) of the Supplier.
