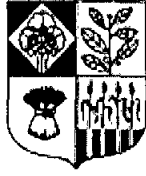

2. Purpose of this Document:

This prequalification document contains brief information about the various services and prequalification process. The purpose of the document is to provide the bidders with information to assist the formulation of their prequalification and to shortlist qualified Interested Parties / consultants to get their services from time to time floating a separate RFP document for each service for the competition among the prequalified firms on a Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method mentioned in PPRA Rules 2004. The bidders are required to provide profiles of their firms comprising experience, personnel and financial strength etc. as required in the prequalification document.

3. Purpose of Assignment / Services:

As per the requirement of TCP, the assignment may focus on followings aspects under the consultancy services including but not limited to;

- i. Design and supervise construction / rehabilitation / revamping / any type of upgradation works for TCP facilities;
- ii. Prepare procurement packages for different type of construction / rehabilitation / revamping / any type of up-gradation works and support TCP in hiring of contractors / vendors;
- iii. Prepare innovative concepts for the development for TCP all over Pakistan; and
- iv. Conduct feasibility studies for any project envisaged by TCP all over Pakistan.

4. Instructions for the Applicants:

- i. The applicants are required to submit their prequalification details in the light of information presented in the preceding paragraphs and their experience and international best practices. The prequalification submission forms are attached as **Annex-A** to **Annex-G** at the end of this document. The required information for each of the eligibility criteria must be submitted on these formats.
- ii. Any misleading statement(s) or information by any Bidder will result into disqualification at any stage.
- iii. Interested consultancy firms shall note that during the period from the receipt of the prequalification document and till further notice, all the queries related to this tender should be communicated via the contact details given below in writing or e-mail only before 5 days prior to the submission of the prequalification document.
- iv. Interested consultancy firms are also required to clearly state in their prequalification document the name, title, fax number and e-mail address of their authorized representative through whom all communications shall be directed until the process has been completed or terminated.

- ii. The bids shall be prepared in accordance with instructions in the pre-qualification document. Complete Tendering process shall be carried out through EPADS.

- iv. Bids will be received only from those firm(s)/bidders(s) who are registered with PPRA E-Procurement on EPADS System. Bids received through fax, email, cable, courier or any other means except as prescribed above shall not be considered.
- v. Applications for prequalification shall be submitted at EPADS on **Friday the 27th September, 2024 by 1000 (hours)**. The applications will be opened on same day by TCP Procurement Committee by **1030 (hours)** in the TCP's Board Room in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives who wish to be present.
- vi. In case the last date of prequalification submission falls in / within the official holidays / weekends of the Procurement agency, the last date for submission of the proposals shall be the next working day. The prequalification document is to be prepared in English language. The bidders must provide complete information along with supporting documents. Any missing against provision of essential information may result in disqualification/ non-responsiveness of the bidder.



6. Validity Period:

The time duration for the consultancy services shall be for 2 years and extendable to 1 year. TCP may terminate the contract if the progress is not up-to the mark as per progress monitoring indicators agreed between the parties under each particular service contract. TCP will not be liable to provide any compensation, whatsoever, under these situations

7. SECURITY DEPOSIT / PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE:-

- i. The applicants short listed for Pre-qualification will be required to furnish Performance Guarantee of Rs.500,000/- (**Rupees Five Lac only**), in the form of Demand Draft or Pay Order in Pak Rupees in favor of Trading Corporation of Pakistan (Pvt.) Limited.
- ii. The Performance Guarantee shall be furnished within 07 working days from the date of issuance of TCP's consent letter.
- iii. The Performance Guarantee will be refunded to the pre-qualified consultant on the successful expiry of the agreement.

8. SIGNING OF AGREEMENT:

- i. Once the firm is enlisted for pre-qualification, the Firm / consultant / Company will be required to sign the agreement with TCP and also submit the Integrity Pact **within 15 days of issuance of award letter**, where applicable. The format of Integrity Pact is attached as **Annexure-F** and the format of agreement is attached as **Annexure-G**.
- ii. The Firm / consultant / Company shall be responsible to complete all documents, as notified from time to time.
- iii. Pre-qualification document, invitation for quotation and integrity pact shall be the integral part of the Agreement / contract.
- iv. The consultancy services already awarded to the consultants against Tender dated 12-09-2022 shall remain valid till completion of the awarded contract.

9. Joint Venture (JV) / Consortium:

All the Joint ventures / consortiums partners may collectively meet the criteria for the pre-qualification. The lead firm may clearly be highlighted in the submitted documents.

10. Qualification Criteria:

A) General:

Prequalification will be based on all the criteria given in succeeding sections regarding the applicants relevant experience, financial soundness, personnel strength etc. as indicated by the applicants responses in the forms given in this document. 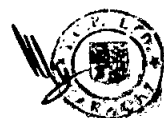

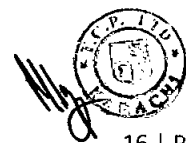

DRAFT AGREEMENT

1. This agreement is made at _____ on this _____ between M/s. Trading Corporation of Pakistan (Pvt.) Limited having their office at 4th & 5th Floor, Block-B, FTC Building, Shakra-e-Faisal, Karachi, through its, authorized (REBD), (hereinafter called as client, which expression, wherever the context so permits, shall mean and include its, successor-in-interest, administrators, and assigns) the party of the First Part.

AND

2. M/s. _____ having their office at _____, though its authorized, Ingr. _____ (hereafter called as Consultant which expression, wherever the context so permits, shall mean and include its heirs, successors interest administrators, attorney/executors and assigns) party of Second Part.

3. WHEREAS the party of 1st part is desirous to hire the service of the party of the 2nd part as Consultant/Architect to render consultancy services to TCP for repairing, renovation/rehabilitation and other engineering works at its various properties at Karachi, Multan and Lahore etc.

4. AND WHEREAS in performance of the Professional Services and the conduct of normal duties, the Consultants shall be governed by the Code Professional Conduct required under rules of professional Associates and bylaws laid down by the Pakistan Engineering Consul and Pakistan Council of Architects and Town Planners and requirements of TCP's Management. The Consultants undertake the responsibility for the drawing, designing, preparation of BOQ, estimates and detailed supervision of the works described by the TCP from time to time.

5. Now the agreement witnesseth as under: -

- a) That in this agreement, words and expressions shall have the same meaning as are respectively assigned to them in the condition of contract hereinafter referred.
- b) In consideration of the terms and conditions given in the agreement, the consultant hereby covenant with the client to design, plan and supervise the execution in conformity in all respect with the provision of this agreement.
- c) The client hereby covenant to the consultant to abide by all terms and conditions and fulfill all its obligation in accordance with the laid down clauses/terms and conditions of this agreement.

6. **SCOPE OF WORK:**

The Consultant's Scope of Works comprising for the package awarded by the Client to the consultant on the basis of lowest cost basis/financial proposal. The following will be responsibilities of the Consultant: -

- i. Design and supervise construction / rehabilitation / revamping / any type of upgradation works for TCP facilities;
- ii. Prepare procurement packages for different type of construction / rehabilitation / revamping / any type of up-gradation works and support TCP in hiring of contractors / vendors;



- iii. Prepare innovative concepts for the development for TCP all over Pakistan; and
- iv. Conduct feasibility studies for any project envisaged by TCP all over Pakistan.

7. **AWARD OF WORKS:**

- i) The pre-qualification does not confer any rights of the consultant for award of works.
- ii) Pre-qualified consultants will be eligible to bid in call for financial proposal when required by the "Client".
- iii) The Client shall obtain quotes from the pre-qualified consultants for any of the assignment or multiple of assignments given in the scope of work for one or more than one site. The contract shall be awarded on the basis of lowest cost basis.
- iv) The work can be awarded to the each Consultant separately subject to their services charges for the estimated work.

8. **PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE:**

- i) Performance Guarantee as required in the tender documents amounting to Rs.500,000/- will remain with TCP till completion of the assignment/expiry of the agreement or delisting of the consultant.
- ii) The Performance Guarantee shall be released after the successful performance of the contract and completion of defect liability period.
- iii) No interest shall be payable on the amount of Performance Guarantee irrespective of the time of release of Performance Bond.

9. **THE CLIENT'S FUNCTIONS:**

- i. To award the approvals of the planning for implementation/Execution.
- ii. To scrutinize and approve the proposals submitted by the Consultant related to the execution.
- iii. To furnish the data required for planning and designing.

10. **Validity Period:**

The time duration for the consultancy services shall be for 2 years and extendable to 1 year. TCP may terminate the contract if the progress is not up-to the mark as per progress monitoring indicators agreed between the parties under each particular service contract. TCP will not be liable to provide any compensation, whatsoever, under these situations.

11. **ARBITRATION:**

Any difference or dispute or liability of whatsoever nature arising out of the contract or in any way relating to the contract or to its construction or fulfillment should be settled as far as possible, amicably between the Consultant & TCP. If the parties fail to come to an amicable settlement the same shall be referred to the Chairman TCP, for final decision. The decision of Chairman TCP shall be final and binding on both the parties i.e. Consultant & TCP.
